Re: Records Requests

Ms. De Fazio:

Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days. Accordingly, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada ("Commission") responds to your following public records requests:

- 1) October 16, 2017, request for "[t]he following copies for Joe Reynolds T&E for the NARUC trip to San Diego. ONLY the FINAL CHECK OUT bill listing all the charges, the hotel confirmation email, copy of the reimbursement check from NARUC for his expenses. There is NO REASON to redact ANYTHING but, credit card info, phone numbers, personal email addresses, home addresses or contact info of the representative of NARUC.
- 2) October 20, 2017, request for a "[c]opy of the PUC's FILE STAMP showing date/time received of comments for 17-07002, where it is posted in the docket, as per statement in transcript page 10."
- 3) October 20, 2017, request for "[a] copy of the signed contract, engaging the services of the court report, including the 'fees' associated with requests for a copy of anything associated with a transcript. Number of copies that are included in the fee. This contract is NOT confidential, as it's a contract that is paid for out of the Mill Tax etc."

NRS 239.0107(1)(c)(2) requires that if the Commission has custody of a requested record but is unable to make the public record available by the end of the fifth business day after the date on

which the request was received, the Commission may provide notice in writing of the date and time after which the record will be available. The Commission hereby notifies you that it may possess some records responsive to your requests. However, additional time is necessary to identify and review the requested records as the Commission currently faces a strain on resources due to workload and staffing issues. Therefore, the Commission cannot guarantee that the requested records will be made available to you before March 2, 2018, by 5:00 p.m. If the requested records are not made available to you by March 2, 2018, at 5:00 p.m., you may inquire regarding the status of your requests.
