Re: Records Request

Ms. De Fazio:

On September 28, 2017, you made a public records request with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada ("Commission") for the following records:

[b]ack up receipts for the room services charges for Mullen for the dates of July 16th (2 charges \$72.12 and \$35.39), July 18th for \$60.11, Shoreline on July 17th for \$17 and \$14, along with a Harbor's Edge Charge to the room for \$66.03. The hotel receipt shows 2 people residing in the room, who is the other person. The reservation note states, that 2 DOUBLE beds are requested. Who utilized the other bed. In discussing this request, I reached out to someone on the AG's Open Meeting Committee and is knowledgeable on Open Records Requests, who stated that the aforementioned request is COVERED under the law and said information is not considered confidential and IS SUBJECT to disclosure. Failure to provide back up for the room services charges CLEARLY SHOWS a LACK of DUE DILIGENCE and FAILURE to ENACT checks and balances for reimbursement requests. Under travel allowances Part B, (6) THIS IS A REQUEST- when is Mullen's doing her presentation on what she learned there. (5) A copy of the list of items (books, handouts, etc) and KNOWLEDGE received from the training in a memo to his/her manager with copies to the DRO or Commission Secretary.

The Commission originally construed this request as duplicative because it sought records that were within the scope of another substantially similar request that was fulfilled the day before, on September 27, 2017. Additionally, the request contained several interrogatories and statements that ultimately obscured the additional records you seek. Indeed, upon re-examination of the request in light of your October 20, 2017, email, it was determined that you sought additional records not

originally contemplated in your August 7, 2017, request. Accordingly, the Commission hereby responds to your September 28, 2017, request in its entirety.

Please be advised that the Commission has no additional receipts responsive to your request beyond what was provided to you on September 27, 2017. To the extent that your submission seeks responses to interrogatories, please be advised that Nevada's public records laws do not require the Commission to provide responses to interrogatories. As such, the Commission declines to respond to your questions.

With respect to your request for "[a] copy of the list of items (books, handouts, etc) and KNOWLEDGE received from the training in a memo to his/her manager with copies to the DRO or Commission Secretary," please be advised that the Commission has no records responsive to your request; however, materials from the event can be found at the following link:
