
Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days. Accordingly, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) responds to your following public records requests:

- 1) December 13, 2017, request for an “[u]pdated phone list” and “[c]opies of the file stamp comments made at the 1 & 6pm Dec 6th consumer sessions, for DeFazio.”
- 2) December 14, 2017, request for “[p]urchase orders, emails, delivery receipts, invoice, payment vouchers, faxes regarding any and all office furniture, related to the three new staff members hired for the CC office. For in person inspection at the LV office.”
- 3) December 15, 2017, request for “[c]opies of the job opportunity postings for the THREE new attorneys.”

NRS 239.0107(1)(c)(2) requires that if the Commission has custody of a requested record but is unable to make the public record available by the end of the fifth business day after the date on which the request was received, the Commission may provide notice in writing of the date and time after which the record will be available. The Commission hereby notifies you that it may possess some records responsive to your requests. However, additional time is necessary to identify and review the requested records as the Commission currently faces a strain on resources due to a high volume of pending filings. Therefore, the Commission cannot guarantee that the requested records will be made available to you before March 2, 2018, by 5:00 p.m. The Commission will endeavor

to provide the records prior to the aforementioned date; however, if the requested records are not made available to you by March 2, 2018, at 5:00 p.m., you may inquire regarding the status of your requests.
