Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days by providing copies of the records or notifying the requestor that the Commission does not have the records and providing the name and address of the governmental entity that does, if known.
