Re: Records Requests

Ms. De Fazio:

Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days. Accordingly, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) is responding to your January 23, 2017, request for “For the balance of 2017, copies of all audio files of agenda meetings.”

The Commission cannot provide the records you request because the records do not exist at this time. Pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code 239.867, an agency is not required to respond to a request for records that do not exist. Given that the agenda meetings scheduled to occur after January 25, 2017, have not yet taken place, there are no audio file records that exist for those meetings. If you would like a copy of the audio recording of a certain agenda meeting in the future, please request the record after the agenda meeting has taken place.
