Dear Ms. De Fazio:

Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days. Accordingly, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) is responding to your June 24, 2016, requests for: 1) “[t]he backup that produced the [Commission’s] January 22, 2016, response to the [Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (‘PHMSA’)];” 2) “[c]opies of any and all [bill draft requests (‘BDRs’)] submitted [by the Commission] for this upcoming legislative session in 2017;” and 3) “[c]op[ies] of Stephanie Mullen’s and Paul Thomsen’s acknowledgment[s] that they read [updates to the Commission’s Administrative Policy M]anual.”
