Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days. Accordingly, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (“Commission”) is responding to your August 1, 2016, request for records that you described as follows:
