Ms. De Fazio:

Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days. Accordingly, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada ("Commission") is responding to your January 9, 2017, request for the following: "From August 2015 to present, a copy of every NARUC submission for subcommittee member recommendations. Since according to policy, these subcommittee nominations come from the chair, a copy of the chair's letter to NARUC with said recommendations. Along with a full detailed list of which committee/subcommittee PUC employees are on."

Attached please find documents that constitute all of the Commission's records responsive to your request. Please note that the attached listing of Commission NARUC representatives is the most current record the Commission has, which is dated August 2, 2016. As an aside, the process you outline for Commission members to participate in NARUC committees and subcommittees is not complete. You cite to the Commission's procedures, but not NARUC's procedures, which the Commission does not control. NARUC can and has asked Commission employees to participate on committees and subcommittees without going through the formal chair appointee process.
