Re: Records Requests

Ms. De Fazio:

Chapter 239 of the Nevada Revised Statutes ("NRS"), specifically NRS 239.0107(1), requires a governmental entity to respond to public records requests within five business days. Accordingly, the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada ("Commission") is responding to your April 6, 2017, requests for the following:

Any and ALL emails, reports etc., related to the email exchange between Garrett and myself regarding the mold/IAQ problem in the LV Office. Including any communications between Susan the lady at the property management company who was SUPPOSE to have a "Stephanie' call me. If there were reports/emails/anything I want copies of such. There is NOT a time considerations as this started on Mrrch 31st, so don't try to claim that it is going to cause time on your part to produce these records. Anything in your possession that relates to the mold/IAQ. Including any so called repairs, including invoices for such. The name of any CIH certified mold testing company's report and their instructions as to how they will produce said test. If you had a remediater come in, the invoice and anything that was given to either the PUC or your building manager.
